Swansea University Bay Campus – Programme Management



Swansea University's Bay Campus is situated on a 65 acre former BP Transit site in Neath Port Talbot on the eastern approach into Swansea. The Campus provides academic, student accommodation and research space, the latter being in a series of agreements with international and national companies.

Facilities include:

- Tower Information Centre, home to central support services for students
- Bay Library
- Students' Union
- Facilities and meeting rooms
- School of Management
- Research and Engineering facilities

Darren Talbot, the founder of D2i Management was appointed by Swansea University as the Programme Manager to lead the Business Case, Feasibility and Pre-Construction elements of the Bay Campus project on behalf of the University. This involved obtaining funding from the ERDF, Welsh Government, EIB and the private sector. The campus is now occupied and has seen student numbers increase by 20% and an increase in research projects of 120% since completion.
